

6101 - SESSION SAFETY BRIEFING FOR ALL BCC MEMBERS AND GUESTS

DURING PLAY:

- ALL PLAYERS ARE ADVISED TO WEAR TWO GRIPPERS AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT DURING DELIVERY. GRIPPERS ARE AVAILABLE FOR USE.
- HELMETS ARE NOT MANDATORY BUT STRONGLY ENCOURAGED. THERE MAY BE ONE AVAILABLE FOR USE UPON REQUEST
- ALL SHOULD REMAIN COGNIZANT OF THEIR SURROUNDINGS AT ALL TIMES AND COMPORT THEMSELVES IN A MANNER RESPECTFUL OF THE SAFETY OF OTHERS. A GOOD PRACTICE, FOR INSTANCE, IS TO ENSURE THAT ALL ROCKS ARE HOUSED AT THE END OF A GAME PRIOR TO SHAKING HANDS

IN THE EVENT OF DISCOVERY OF FIRE:

- DO NOT ATTEMPT TO EXTINGUISH
- PULL THE FIRE ALARMS (LOCATED AT EXITS)

IN THE EVENT OF AN AUDIBLE ALARM:

- IMMEDIATELY EVACUATE THE BUILDING BY THE NEAREST MARKED EXIT
- MOVE TO A POSITION WELL AWAY FROM THE BUILDING NEAR THE TRANSFORMER ON THE EAST SIDE AND AWAIT FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS
- OUTSIDE, REMAIN WITH YOUR TEAM/ICE MATES AND VALIDATE EVERYONE IS THERE

IN THE EVENT OF A FALL OR OBVIOUS DISTRESS OF A MEMBER:

- MOVE TO ASSIST THE MEMBER AND INITIATE COMMUNICATION
- IDENTIFY THE DESIGNATED RESPONSIBLE PERSON (DRP) – ALL STAFF, LEAGUE DIRECTOR, CONVENORS, EVENT ORGANIZER - WHO WILL ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR NEXT STEPS
- DEFIBRILLATOR AND FIRST AID KIT ARE LOCATED ON THE EAST WALL OF THE LOBBY JUST OUTSIDE THE ICE TECHNICIANS' OFFICE. A SECOND FIRST AID KIT IS LOCATED IN THE CABINET OUTSIDE THE CLUB MANAGERS OFFICE
- IF A FALL HAS RESULTED IN HEAD OR HELMET CONTACT WITH THE ICE, CALL 911. PLAYER CAN ONLY RETURN TO PLAY IN THEIR NEXT REGULARLY SCHEDULED GAME IF THEY ARE EITHER CLEARED BY THE AMBULANCE ATTENDANT OR PROVIDE A NOTE FROM A PHYSICIAN OR NURSE PRACTITIONER INDICATING THEY ARE ABLE TO RESUME PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES SUCH AS CURLING

THE BAR IS AVAILABLE AS A COURTESY

- MEMBERS SHOULD CONSUME RESPONSIBLY AND ARE LIKEWISE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR GUESTS
- INTOXICATED MEMBERS/GUESTS SHALL BE ASKED TO LEAVE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SAFE SERVE PROCEDURES & PRACTICES
- IT IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY TO POLICE SAFE USAGE

MEMBERS ARE REMINDED TO FOSTER AN ENVIRONMENT OF:
COURTEOUS AND CONSIDERATE CONDUCT
SAFETY FROM HARASSMENT OR DISCRIMINATION
